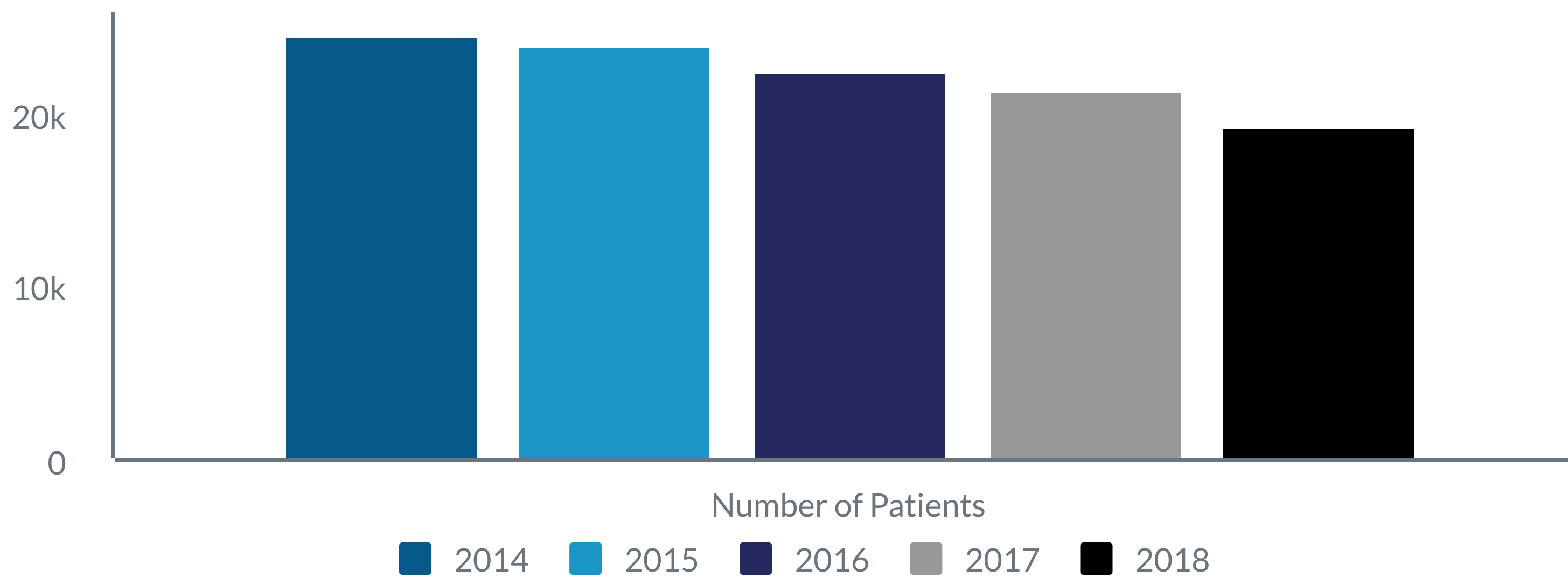

Number of Patients Receiving Opioids for Pain



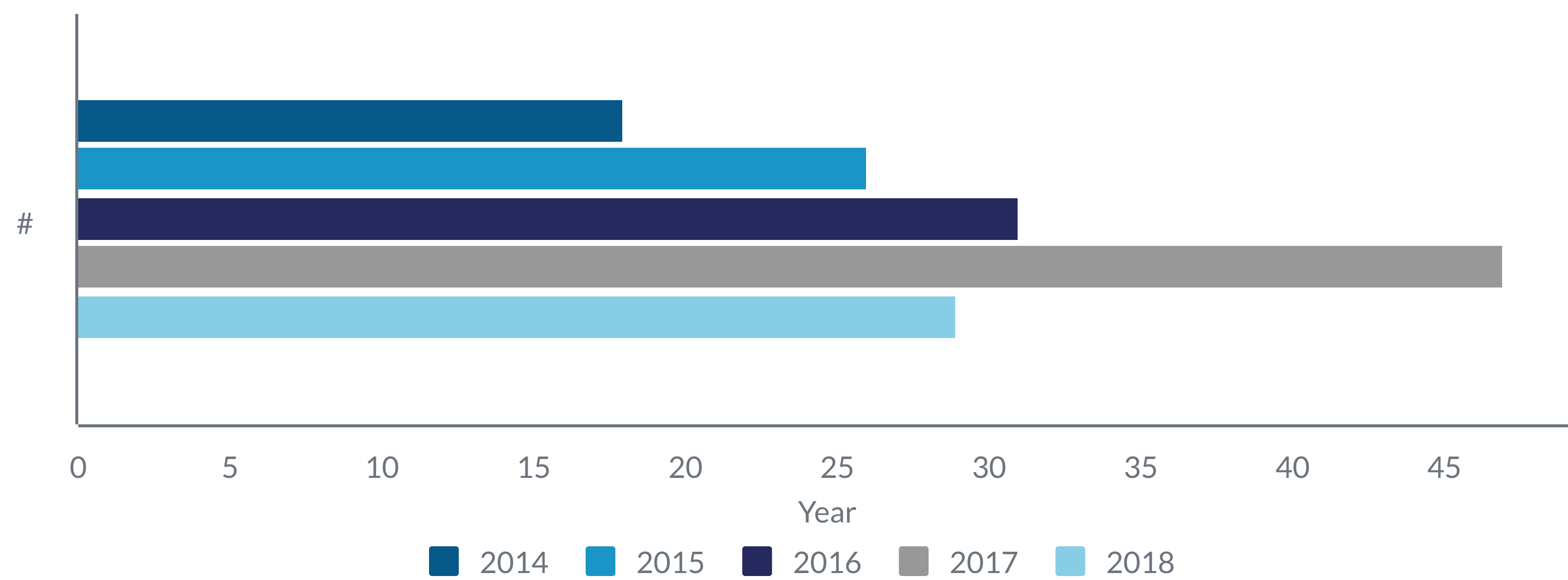
PRESCRIBED OPIOIDS

- 14%** Overlapping with benzodiazepine prescription
- 30%** Decrease in opioid prescriptions for pain
- Top 3** TOP 3 FILLED PRESCRIPTION OPIOIDS
 - Hydrocodone
 - Oxycodone
 - Tramadol

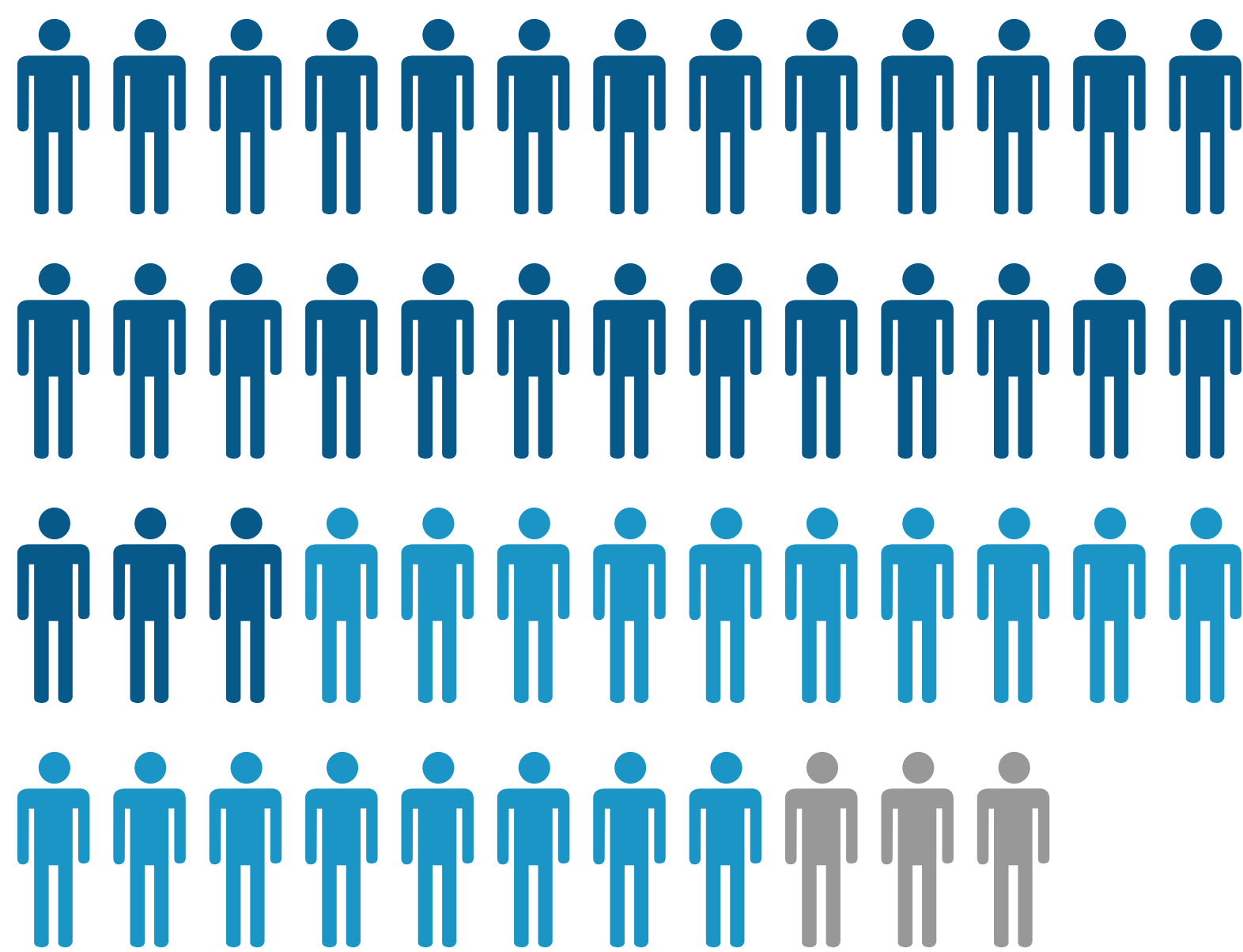
Overdose deaths peaked at 59.7/100,000 in 2017, climbing steadily since 2014 (20.1/100,000). While overdose deaths continue to increase statewide, this is the first measurable decline identified in the tri-county region still, 29 people lost their life to overdose last year. Opioid overdoses account for 62% of all drug overdoses.

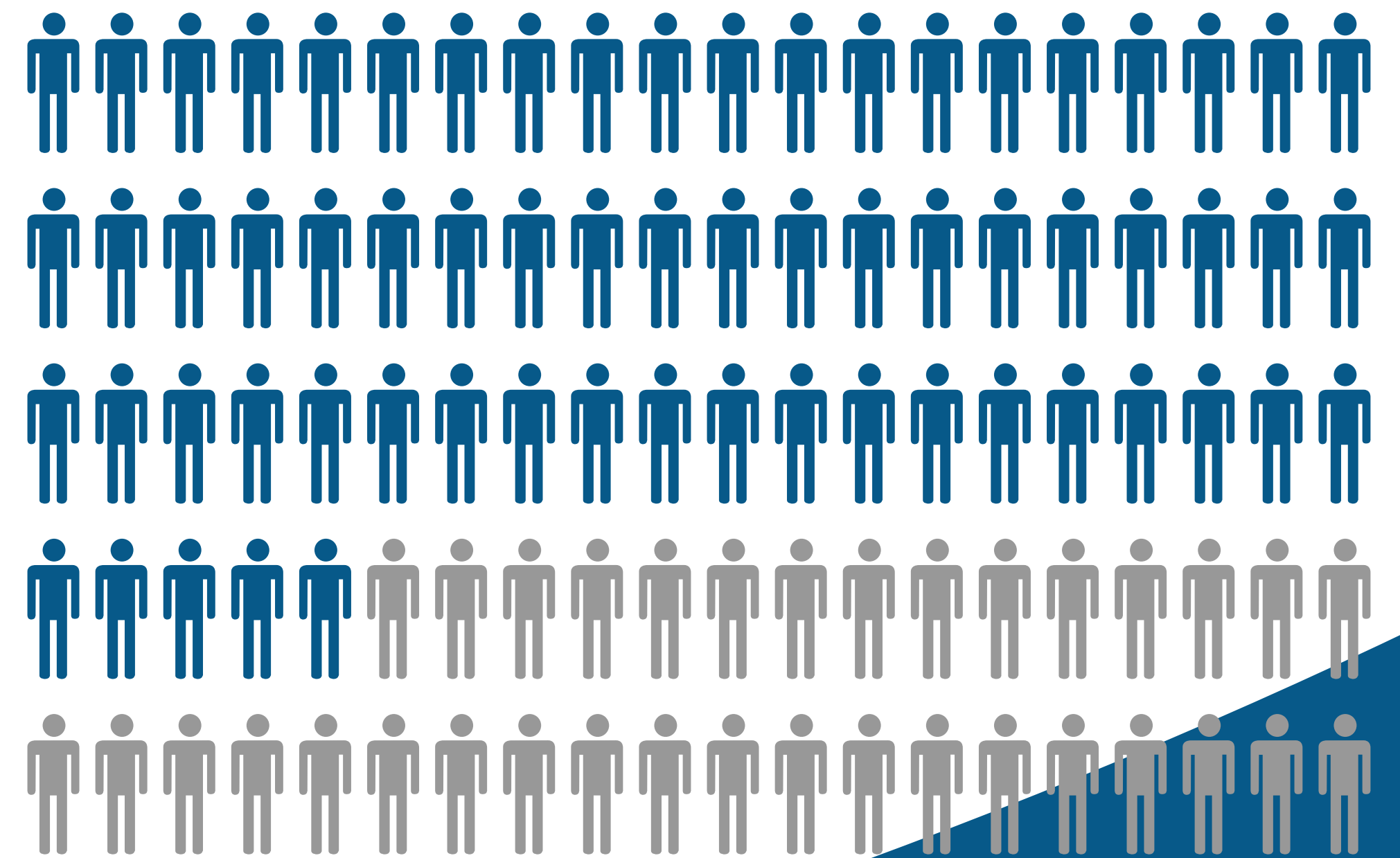


FATAL OVERDOSES
